Upcoming out of hours works: Inner City Bypass and Victoria Park Road, Kelvin Grove

Between Sunday 11 December 2011 and Friday 23 December 2011, Transcity will complete construction of the new Victoria Park Road access to and from the Inner City Bypass (ICB). During this period, the ICB will also be reduced to two lanes of traffic eastbound, between the current Victoria Park Road and the Inner Northern Busway.

Victoria Park Road changes

This connection will be undertaken **between 8pm and 5am** over **approximately five nights during this period**, as a lane closure is required on the ICB for safety reasons and to reduce traffic impacts at peak times.

The relocated Victoria Park Road will be open to all vehicle traffic (see overleaf).

The relocation is to allow for the construction of the new tunnel entry and exit portals.

A roundabout will be created on the new Victoria Park Road for the safety of all traffic, including Brisbane Grammar School (BGS) and construction related traffic.

Inner City Bypass changes

From mid-December 2011, the ICB will be reduced to two lanes of traffic to allow for construction of the eastern tunnel portals.

A new construction site access will be constructed off the ICB. This access will be an entry point only with traffic control in place when required.

Concrete barriers, screening and traffic signage will be in place for the safety of motorists and construction workers. The speed limit in this area will be 60km/h.

Traffic changes may be delayed due to weather or other circumstances. If this occurs, Transcity will carry out these works on the next available night.

What to expect:

- Lane closures on the ICB at night to safely create the connection
- Closure of the existing Victoria Park Road entry and exit to the ICB and opening of the new Victoria Park Road
- Use of machinery such as franna cranes, saw cutter, light towers and large vehicles
- Small line marking vehicles
- Some construction noise during connection activities
- Vehicles and equipment fitted with flashing lights and white noise reversing beepers for safety.

Brisbane Grammar School (BGS) car park access

Access to the BGS car park for vehicles and pedestrians will also be via the relocated Victoria Park Road.

Why does this work need to occur at night?

Throughout the construction of Legacy Way, Transcity will do the majority of surface works during day shifts. However, for safety reasons and to reduce the impact on local and peak hour traffic, some work will need to be carried out at night.

Our project

Legacy Way is a 4.6km road tunnel that will connect the Western Freeway at Toowong with the ICB at Kelvin Grove. It will provide an alternative route to local roads for traffic leaving the Western Freeway and travelling to and from the ICB. When it opens, Legacy Way will reduce, by up to 44%, the peak hour travel time of journeys from the Centenary Bridge to the ICB.
